the association board held in February it was decided to dissolve the association and shift some of the goals and tasks of the AAFLP to the Family Ministries Department of the North American Division. (Read more.)

It is the end of a productive endeavor but it marks the beginning of another. For the last four years, there has been a strong partnership between the GC and NAD Family Ministries Departments and Andrews University to host the Adventist Conference on Family Research and Practice (ACFRP). During these last four years we have had outstanding and renown researchers like Rene Drumm, Scott Stanley, and David Olson, and inspirational messages from Mark Finley, Delbert and Susan Baker, and Roger and Kathy Hernandez, just to mention a few. Instead of the AAFLP Research Forum, which was not attended by many, the transitioning of this to the ACFRP meant the offering of numerous research and practice presentations, therefore dramatically increasing the interest and attendance. Dissolving the AAFLP affords us the opportunity to focus more of our attention to continue to strengthen the ACFRP and to have a wider reach and benefit to family life professionals and to Adventist Church members and others interested in a family ministries focus.

Solomon wisely wrote, "There's an opportune time to do things, a right time for everything on the earth: A right time for birth and another for death, A right time to plant and another to reap, A right time to kill and another to heal, A right time to destroy and another to construct, A right time to cry and another to laugh, A right time to lament and another to cheer, A right time to make love and another to abstain, A right time to embrace and another to part, A right time to search and another to count your losses, A right time to hold on and another to let go, A right time to rip out and another to mend, A right time to shut up and another to speak up, A right time to love and another to hate. On March 18-20, over 700 men from Florida and surrounding states, and many from as far as the Bahamas and the Cayman Islands, gathered at Camp Kulaqua Retreat and Conference Center, in northern Florida, for the annual English Men's Convention. Dr. Claudio Consuegra was one of the main speakers along with Dr. Everett Brown, president of the Jamaica Union, and others. John Earnhardt, childhood friend of the late race car driver Dale Earnhardt, also spoke about his memories of the famous driver and lessons he has learned for men.

The Florida Conference conducts two men's conventions in French, two in Spanish, one in Portuguese, and one in English, for a total annual attendance of over 3,000 men. The theme of this year's English convention was, "Run the Race." (Convention program.)
