Mazat Award

We're happy to announce that the 2017 Mazat Award is being presented to Ashley C. Reddy, from Andrews University. (Read more.) Among the requirements, Ashley submitted her paper entitled, "Family, a preventive and protective factor for children against substance use and abuse (Marijuana), and its implication for Youth Ministry," which was written in partial fulfillment of the requirements for the class "Families and Addictions." Ashley will be presented with the award and a \$500 check which accompanies it. Here's the concluding paragraphs of her paper as a sample of her outstanding work.

As delineated throughout this paper, research provides overwhelming evidence that the family is a preventive and protective factor for children against substance use and abuse. The questions then are: why is there still such an annual increase in drug use and addiction, and what is being done to curb such drug use and abuse? If the cycles of addiction are so prevalent, surely more needs to be done to rehabilitate dysfunctional families, and proactively skill and empower those families that have healthy functioning. With addiction engendering both financial and moral deleterious implications at all levels of society, government and private agencies need to synergize their efforts of investigation and program intervention. There appears to be greater fragmented efforts and emphases afforded symptomatic treatment of addiction, than preventive and protective initiatives. Mejía and Restrepo (2009) confirm that between 2000 and 2005, the US government forked out approximately \$3.8 billion towards the prevention of drug trafficking from Columbia to the rest of the world. If such exorbitant amounts were spent on programs to rehabilitate and support families, the market for drugs will dwindle, and governments and societies will be the beneficiaries.

Whilst efforts are concentrated at the macro level, is there an answer to the 'cries' at the micro level, and what impact will this have? The answers lies in youth ministry which is strategically positioned at the micro level, can direct a catalytic influence on families and
